The Garden Railroad Hobby & Retirement: Is It For You?

Today, we are all living much longer and we often live longer in retirement than we spent working. So...how do we fill that time? G Gauge trains are the perfect solution to that question. They are big enough to see and handle, and their operation is not too strenuous for seniors to accomplish.

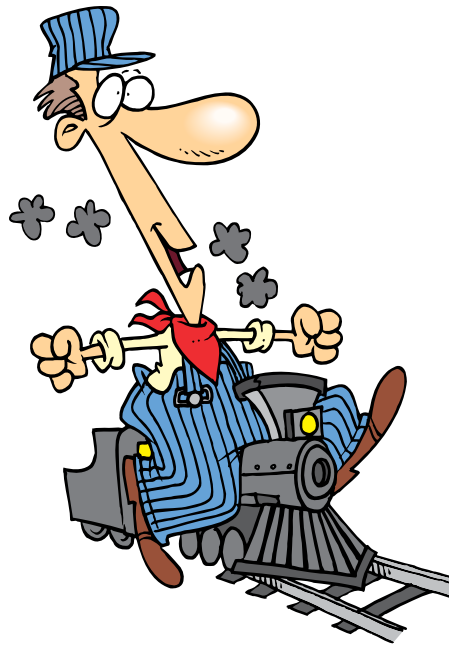
The fact that they are a hobby that is done at home, without having to drive to a remote location is a great plus. Gas is saved, and the rest of your family knows where you are always. Gardening is the biggest hobby in America, if not the world, and it's something a spouse can do along side of the railroader as well as the scenic details of the layout are often done by the distaff side of the family with great enjoyment.

This bodes well for G Gauge, and we need to get this message out there to retirees and those planning for that stage of life. With only 30,000 or so active hobbyists in G, we need to expand that number to the many millions of retirees who are bored and restless.

We do need to make the entry level cost much lower and make the setup easier. ARISTO-CRAFT's idea is to go with plastic roadbed track and battery operation to simplify electrical connectivity problems and the possible problem of leaving a power supply exposed in inclement weather. The power supply should always be kept under cover, but we're

human, and remembering this safety factory is not always at the top of our list.

Plastic track is made from an engineering plastic that is rock hard and has u.v. protection. The track



pieces lock together, and they have drain holes for rain runoff. While we would suggest pulling up the grass where the roadbed will lay, a ditch does not have to be built. The track lies free floating on the ground and can be spiked in with small nails to hold it loosely in place.

Radio control is the key to running battery operated trains, and we're going to make a basic version of our Revolution. This version can

control up to six trains and will be on 2.4 Ghz. If more features are needed, it's a logical pathway up to the full version. This basic version will be in the \$50 MSRP range and will give great stability to the entry-level hobbyist. It will work simply and steadily and allow a quick path to personal satisfaction of how their trains operate.

Our goal also is to have smaller battery packs to keep the price more affordable and several packs can be linked for longer running if needed. These packs will be in a trailing car, so that recharging and swapping can be done in a short time and without having to open a loco. All our trains have a battery plug external to the engine and it can easily be plugged in to the trailing car.

A simple loop with great plantings will get people started at a reasonable entry price, and the layout can be expanded as time and money allow. Most of us would rather spend our money on a new train as the enjoyment keeps giving pleasure for many hours instead of a onetime few hours. A mix is needed, but we hope the balance will favor a layout expansion.

Another thing needed is to raise the trains off the ground as many of us seniors can't go up and down as easily as we used to. We recommend purchasing 8'x30" tables at HOME DEPOT and then using lawn trim

The SW-1...It's Planning & Design

ARISTO-CRAFT wanted to make a small locomotive after releasing the Consolidation and re-releasing the Mallet and Pacific, that are all large locos for big layouts. John Mikesh, our product manager, selected the SW-1 as a great candidate for the next loco we could make. The problem always is getting the good research detail and when we discussed this with our designer, Steve Gugel, he knew of a current version in his Baltimore area that he could photograph and study

A main advantage of the SW-1 is that it was produced in a large variety of road names and these will be popular all over the country. Having a loco that was used all over the country means we could legitimately produce a wide range of product over the years. In other words, this is an evergreen process for the investment in the molds.

This is a very low profile loco and we had just developed the PCC

Trolley gearbox we knew we had a reliable drive for this loco that would allow the correct height appropriate and possible. We will lengthen the size of the gearbox, but keep the height. In fact, we did not have a single return on the PCC's, though we did have a loud complaint of it sounding loud that was not repeated by anyone else. One out of thousands is a respectable defect rate and we have not had a loco returned since the new Sanda Kan came into being.

We did learn from the PCC in that we had to make adjustments for the die cast chassis, so that the metal wheels would not touch the metal chassis and cause shorts. We changed the drawings before going to the mold production status where the costs are minimal in relation to changing molds after they were produced.

We also produced a cover for the REVOLUTION/DCC port to stop any

sidings to build up the side of the table by 3" or so. Then use potting soil to allow plantings of choice to enhance the environment. The tables can be moved if you have to move your residence, and they are rugged enough to resist any inclement weather your region might endure. A second type of four or 6' table can be put in corners to allow return loop diameters and to allow most diameter track to be used.

Even water events can be used on the tabletops, and pumps and accoutrements can be hidden under the table. If 8' is standardized on the tables can even be moved to modular layouts at shows with easy on and off on panel trucks.

Everybody loves trains, and we need to make it easier to share in the fun!

smoke fluid overflow from affecting the PCB board. Like the PCC, we will use a special Teflon tube to protect the wires from touching the metal chassis if the plastic covering



wears when the motor drive pivots.

This is a small loco, so we felt adding weights alone was questionable and the die cast chassis adds weight below the center of gravity. This worked very well with the PCC Trolley and the smooth running and holding of turns on the track is due to this low center of gravity weight.

Of course, we worked super hard on getting all the details of the original into the mold. Both John Mikesh and Steve Gugel have created a model that is an exact replica and still allows our model functions to be incorporated.



Still to come is a test period with the first test shots and engineering sample. Navin Shievdayal, working with JK Kim, our engineer, put the loco through its tests that supplement the 100-hour test at the factory. Navin has to fix any problems and his goal is to be like the Maytag repairman and not have anything to do. Navin also handles parts and customer service on the REVOLUTION R/C, so no repairs is a plus.

Creating a new product from scratch is a miracle process. Steve Gugel spent hundreds of hours on the accurate design and that includes the appropriate design for the power brick with appropriate side frames, pole holes, areas for sounds to come through the body, correct handrails and a hundred other check points for accuracy. Then we get engineering drawings to review in advance of cutting the first piece of steel, which is an art form unto itself. If I may remind you that once the engineering drawings are done in 3D, someone else has to redraw these in reverse to cut the steel. If a mistake is made on the originals it magnifies in the reverse drawing. This last drawing also has to take into account the fact

that some parts shrink at a different rate depending on its distance from the molten plastic is inserted, the type of material being used and the pressure of the injection machine of the plastic.



Then we have to check the injection for sinkholes and shrink defects that are a normal part of the process. Rectifying molds is an



art unto itself, but Sanda Kan is an expert mold maker and finds most of the problems on her own, making our job easier.

Once we have a rectified model, we turn it over to Michael J. to do the detailed artwork for each selected road name. That's another story on its own, he's the most experienced commercial artist in the design of model train paint schemes.

It's a complicated process, but a necessary one to provide the hobbyist with the level of fidelity to scale and reliable operation. I think *Team Aristo* has now achieved a higher level of providing a product that is trouble free. We look forward to this release next year.

Manufacturing in the Far East Versus the United States – An Explanation

After the defeat of the Japanese in WWII, General MacArthur was looking for a way to re-establish commerce in his arena of supervision. MacArthur established a letter of credit system, where the purchase confirmed advanced payment with a corresponding bank and the local Japanese bank would loan money to the domestic supplier allowing them to make purchases to complete that product that was guaranteed on the L/C (Letter of Credit).

The manufacturer would order just enough parts to complete the order and ship to match the payment

generate sufficient profit to modernize equipment regularly.

Western manufacturers are expected to keep inventory on the shelves and are reluctant to upgrade molds and machinery to keep costs down. This is a more normal way of doing business (at least in the United States), but does slow down the rectification of molds and improvement of the molds and machinery that is the heart of the manufacturing process. This also tends to keep prices high and only re-negotiated annually instead of on an order-by-order basis.

can't be stored too long before the goods are to be shipped as they take up valuable space in the warehouse. Usually, goods are produced and shipped within the same month to keep the high cost of warehouse space needed to no more than what is required to be shipped that month. If you get a single container a month, the warehouse will only hold the equivalent of a single container.

If we order parts, they have to be on the same purchase order as the production quantity as minimum production runs for parts is too high unless shared with the actual production of the item.

A Purchase Order is the trigger and end result of what was ordered several months in advance to allow an orderly purchasing of parts. If there were 10% leftover parts for each order they would soon fill the warehouse and eat up any chance for a profit on the production of the item for the factory.

of the L/C. Thus there was no inventory and each time they got a repeat order, they were able to upgrade the manufacturing based upon the results of the last order.

All costs of development of the product were bourn by the foreign (domestic) customer and only the parts and labor were used from the supplying country and company.

This worked well and Japan and the other Oriental manufacturers grew into powerhouses without worries about development and inventory. The rapid upgrades of the order-by-order process meant there was no inventory on the shelves to become obsolete and the sub-suppliers that survived were those that could deliver quickly and were financially strong as they were paid in advance by the L/C formula.

The Oriental manufacturers are also able to constantly upgrade the efficiency of their machines as faster and better production allows them to do more sales and thus

While there are pluses and minuses for both methods for model train manufacturing, the improvements on a production-by-production basis is better. Model trains are not made every day—it's more likely to be just twice a year. Manufacturing the same item daily is much easier than short run products run again several months or even years later.

This is accomplished by MRP (Manufacturing Resource Production software) that computerizes every part and the number needed with a full spec and part number to be ordered when an order is received. By pushing a single number (all parts, their lead times, the number of plastic parts from the mold), recommended suppliers get purchase orders for this product. When all parts are received you can then plan production as a single missing screw, for example, could stop all production.

This is followed through by *just in time* delivery of packaging that



So...we can't order off the shelf and have FEDEX fill up our warehouse everyday. We have to look at the sales for the past 6 months and order for the upcoming 6 months to arrive as the on hand goods are depleted.

It's not efficient for the product chain, but does give the lowest possible costs.

A LIL' THIS 'N THAT

We send and receive a dozen e-mails a day from our engineering team at Sanda Kan. Some of the daily issues are as follows.

- Wheel flanges for all locos including the back-to-back, depth and thickness.
- New project design issues. Several designs have been done by Steve Gugel who does the rectifications of models he did, but he does check with me to get my opinion.
- PCB board designs that we provide and sample checking.
- Dozens of design issues on the SW-1
- Packaging design of boxes and foam.
- Parts choices and sourcing.
- Explanations of new product operating features that are not show in the raw designs.
- Explanations of artwork on the trains that might include overlapping pad designs or colors of the printing if not just black.
- Manual changes in new runs where the product has changed.
- Production dates often based on parts supply.
- Design of packaging done by our Michael J.
- Labeling and bar coding questions.
- Choice of plastics to be used on various parts of the loco and the parts that need a different material have to be in the same mold in order to be changed.
- Accounting questions.
- New part numbers for spare parts and later their pricing.
- Discussions of new samples received and their approval or not.
- 0-4-0 new project design with new gearboxes and a new style smoke. We have added a flickering light box and this has to be explained along with the program on a computer chip to make the flickering happen
- Discussion of the 0-4-0 with the tender for normal production and without a tender in starter sets for 2012.
- Discussion of the new style numbers when we add new road names, not just new products.
- Packaging tests for drop testing.

This is just one typical day and the topics change on a daily basis. We notify a dozen people with a copy of each e-mail so everyone is updated on the topic simultaneously. Picture attachments accompany almost every e-mail, since many of the people the need to actually do the work can see what we want or vice-versa as many do not read English. Reflective stripes and lettering on railroad equipment has become the norm over the last 15 years and C.A.B. has developed a practical application for model railroads in all scales.

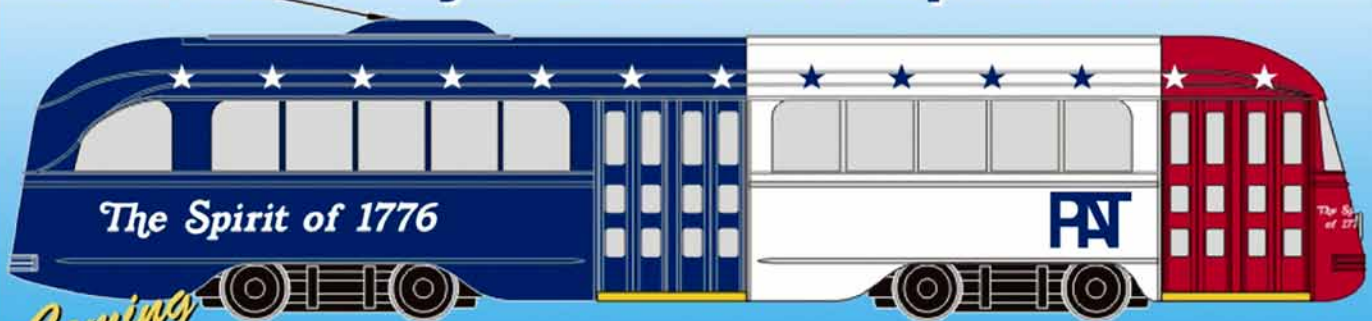

The Aristo-Craft Railroad Club: A Bit of History (1996 & 1997)

For this article we shall take a look at two years in the history books of the ARISTO-CRAFT Railroad Club. Both years you received a club membership card, a membership certificate suitable for framing, all the catalogs that were released during your membership year and the special edition club car for that year. As in the first two years of the club, Lewis Polk continued adding his personal touch to our membership by signing our membership certificates.



When the club cars came by the brown truck, there was no doubt as to what was in the shipping box. The shipping boxes were clearly labeled with ARISTO-CRAFT Railroad Club, the bottom told what year it was for and what the club car was. The 1996 box was the only club car that I received that had my membership number written in on the shipping box as the cars serial number. The 1996 ARISTO-CRAFT Railroad Club Car was a new design of cars and the YELLOW Box stated it was part of the DELTON CLASSICS. It was numbered as ART# 81096.



The Gondola had the ARISTO-CRAFT red diamond with the DELTON CLASSICS at the bottom of the diamond. Under the “road name” of ARISTO-CRAFT was the wording “introducing ARISTO-CRAFT Trains Entry into the Classic Era Of Railroading – 1996” There was a label that said #1 Gauge and 1:24 Scale. Some of the smaller print on this car was interesting. There was a black box (return card) in the bottom center and it said “Return to ARISTO Silver Mine, Silverton, Colorado Ore loading

only” and under the ARISTO-CRAFT red diamond was another box that said “Limited Edition Made Especially For ARISTO-CRAFT Train Club Members.” This club car was a welcome addition for very many *Aristo-Nauts*.

The 1997 ARISTO-CRAFT Railroad Club car was a special year for the club. This year there were TWO issues of club cars. Members could choose either the 1:24 Railroad Club Car or the 1:29 Railroad Club Car. If you choose both cars you would have to pay a second \$50.00 club fee. The 1:24 scale club car was a flat car with cable reels and was another from the DELTON CLASSICS series.



Upon close inspection of the reels, they had real wire rolled onto the reels. This club car was labeled as Track Maintenance Service, the first of several club issues in the “MOW” group. The reels ‘snapped’ into their holders. When I first opened my box and saw one of the reels loose in the box, I thought it was broken and I would have to ask for a replacement. But after close inspection of the car, I figured out that it would snap back into place.



The second ARISTO-CRAFT Railroad Club Car was a 1:29 drop end gondola. It came in with the road name of Track Maintenance Service. It was ART# 41099. It was another great addition to the growing lineup of ARISTO-CRAFT Railroad Club Cars. It should be noted that it is very rare that these three Railroad Club Cars can be found at shows or on the internet for sale. With that thought in mind, one could think that these ARISTO-CRAFT Railroad Club Cars are prized possessions. *I know they are to me.* ♦

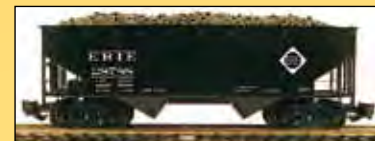

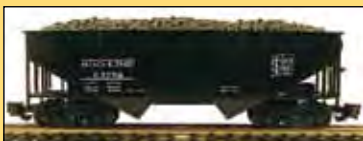

A NEW PWC TO LINEAR ACCESSORY

APPLE COMPUTER has been successful by having an operating system to control a single computer model and MICROSOFT has been even more successful by making their operating system work with hundreds of computer systems. Obviously, the MICROSOFT way is far more complicated, but for the most part, they have succeeded in providing a product that has brought computer control to a large marketplace.

ARISTO-CRAFT is manufacturing in a very niche market and that market is powered by a dozen or so power systems. We need to make our product compatible with all types of power choices and this new accessory helps do just that. While battery power is the system of choice for us, we understand the investment made in all the track power systems. All legacy systems work and we will continue to support the choices made by our customers.

When designing our Revolution, we decided to stay with PWC as compared to a linear control or even providing a choice. We design for

90% of the marketplace, knowing there is always 10% that will require more than we can successfully provide in a manner that is usable for most users. PWC is the control device for motors and has been for many years in most markets. Linear has been in use in the model train field for 100+ years and is a mode that was used by legacy products, especially sound boards. Today's sound systems have adopted the

PWC control system, but many people have these older sound



systems that have a significant monetary investment.

Also, since our receiver boards control the single train, not the trackage on the layout, the instant emergency stop is not possible with the REVOLUTION system. Therefore, we are allowing a retrograde that allows older sound systems to operate and to have an instant stop of all trains running on a single powered track system.

When using PWC power to operate a PWC-powered loco, the signals interfere with each other due to conflicting wave patterns. Thus, we have engineered a small board that will go between our track powered *Base Station* (CRE57004) and the track. Use setting 00 and a depression of that setting will stop all power going to the track and thus an instant emergency stop. Also, the clean signal now in effect will allow those legacy systems to operate with a pure, clean signal and operate as designed. This new part is called CRE57091 and will be available in late September 2011 for \$30 MSRP.

This was not an easy part to engineer as it has to carry large current and thus requires large capacity components. However, that's our job and the unit exceeds our goals and let's you operate in linear mode if necessary.

You can use this new accessory if you wish to use the base station/super receiver and on board receivers in combination. It's not something we contemplated initially, but we listen to our customers. ♦

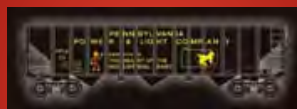

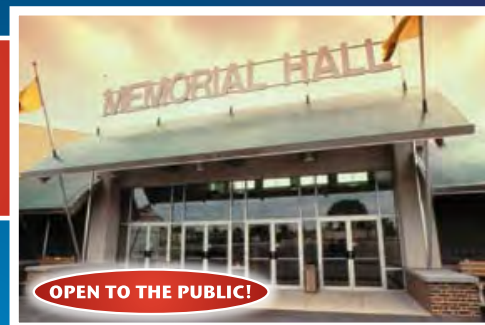
